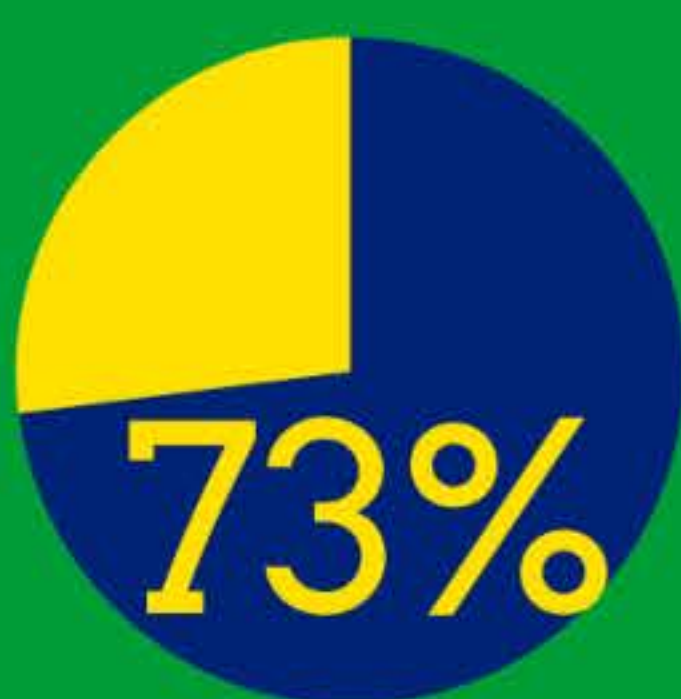
5 in 10 Brazilians believe that Brazil is "a democracy with big problems."



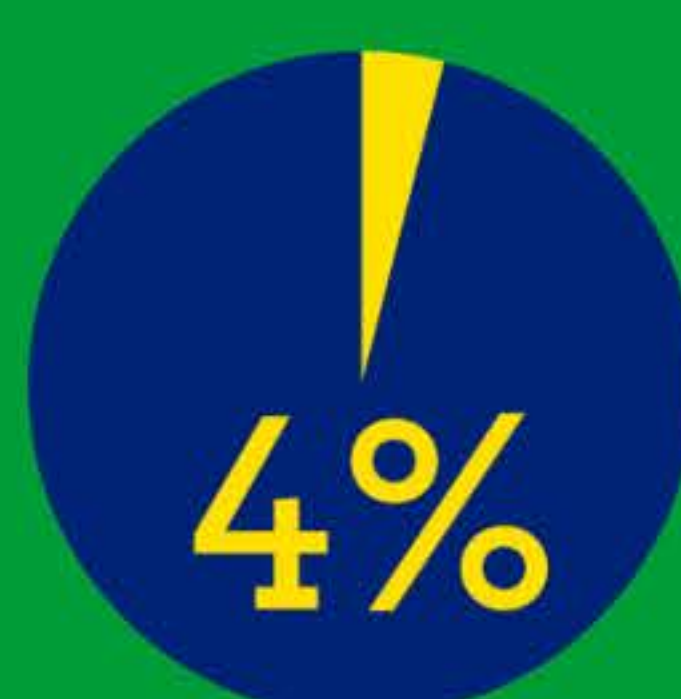
Only **1 in 10** think that politicians act with the populace's interests in mind.

Believe Brazil's government is corrupt



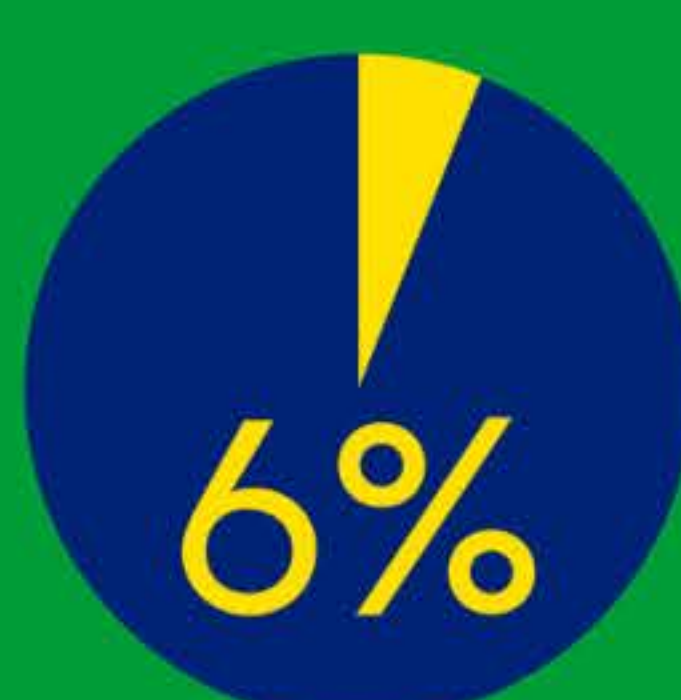
Confidence in government's capabilities
